



edX-course – Online Campus Essentials

1. Description of programme

Since the beginning of 2020, ZHAW has been a partner organisation of edX, which offers access to over 3500 online courses, mainly in English. For the third time, edX is offering its partner organisations free access to [a specific selection of otherwise fee-based courses](#). Access licences - for individuals or entire classes - can be obtained via "ZHAW digital". Course **enrolment must be completed by 30 June 2022**; the completion of the course can also take place later, within the framework of the selected course.

Important: The completion of these offered courses is voluntary for the students. As these courses are not a fixed part of degree programmes, they are never compulsory for students.

This instruction only applies to "verified" enrolments, as there are some restrictions when enrolling as a guest. Licences can only be redeemed with a ZHAW email account registration.

2. Find a course

Go to [the edX course catalogue](#) specific to this offer (no user account required). In the filter (Filter by category), click on the desired category(ies) and select the course.

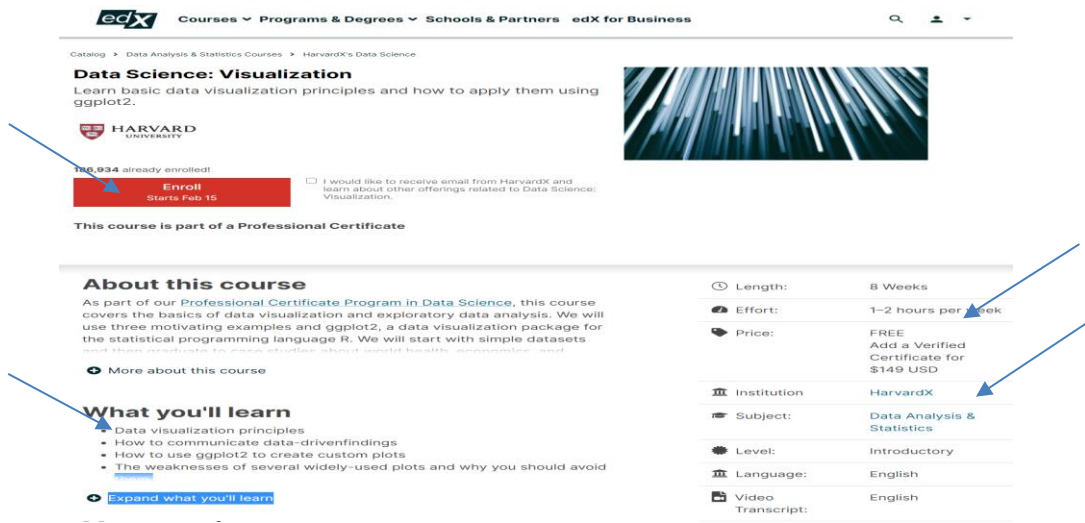

3. Request a licence

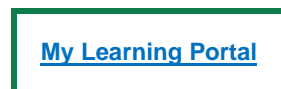
- Send an email to digital@zhaw.ch by indicating the exact email address (short or long written form?).

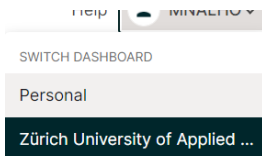

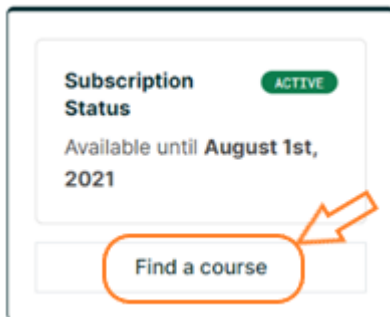

4. Enrolment procedure

- a) In the received email click on **Activate Your License**.
- b) After the login process, you must check at the top right of your edx user name whether you are in the 'Zürich University of Applied Sciences' view (if not > you have to select it).



- c) In the *Subscription Status* window on your right side click on *Find a course*.



- d) In the search field, copy-paste the course title, to ensure that the correct course is selected.
- e) Click on the course and then on *Enrol*.
